Benefits for Children with Disabilities

To be eligible for SSI benefits, children with autism must have:

- Deficits in social interaction
- Deficits in verbal and nonverbal communication
- Significantly restricted, repetitive patterns of behavior, interest, or activities

Provides comprehensive mental health care to enhance the emotional wellbeing of infants, toddlers, and preschoolers struggling with severe behavioral problems. Services include autism therapy, mental health evaluation, therapeutic childcare, parent and general counseling, volunteer opportunities, and evidence-based program models for prevention including Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (TF-CBT).
